Duration: 6 months (Residential Pre-Sea Training)

Eligibility: 10th standard pass with at least 40% aggregate marks in Science, Mathematics and English



Certificate Course in Maritime Catering (CCMC)

Duration: 6 months (Residential Pre-Sea Training)

Eligibility: 10th standard pass with minimum 40% aggregate and 40% in English



Diploma in Nautical Science (DNS)

Duration: 1 year (Residential Pre-Sea Diploma)

Eligibility: 10+2 (Science) with PCM average 60% and at least 50% in English

B.Sc. in Nautical Science

Duration: 3 years (Residential Undergraduate Degree)

Eligibility: 10+2 (Science) with PCM g 60% and minimum 50% in English



B.Tech in Marine Engineering

Duration: 4 years (Residential Undergraduate Degree)

Eligibility: 10+2 (Science) with PCM g 60% and at least 50% in English



B.Tech in Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering

Duration: 4 years (Residential Undergraduate Degree)

Eligibility: 10+2 (Science) with PCM g 60% and at least 50% in English





Graduate Marine Engineering (GME)

Duration: 1 year(Residential Post-Graduate Diploma)

Eligibility: B.E./B.Tech in Mechanical Engineering or Naval Architecture with at least 50% marks



Electro Technical Officer (ETO) Course

Duration: 4 months(Pre-Sea Training)

Eligibility: B.E./B.Tech in Electrical Engineering or related fields with at least 50% marks

How to Join the Merchant Navy

Joining the merchant navy is an exciting process that involves meeting certain eligibility criteria and completing requisite training. Below is a step-by-step guide for prospective students:

Meet Eligibility Requirements

Prospective cadets must have a suitable educational background and age. For officer cadre courses, this typically means having completed 10+2 (higher secondary) with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics) for deck or engine programs, or at least 10th standard for rating courses. Age limits generally range from 17 to 25 years for entry-level programs.

Qualify the IMU-CET Entrance Exam

For officer-level courses (like B.Sc Nautical Science, Diploma in Nautical Science, B.Tech Marine Engineering, etc.), clearing the Indian Maritime University Common Entrance Test (IMU-CET) is mandatory.

Obtain Sponsorship

Certain courses, especially the Diploma in Nautical Science (DNS), often require candidates to be sponsored by a shipping company before enrollment. Captain's Maritime Academy assists students in securing sponsorships.

Enroll in a Pre-Sea Training Course

Once you have your IMU-CET rank (and sponsorship if needed), you can enroll in the appropriate pre-sea training program at our academy.

After completing the on-campus course, you will typically proceed to onboard training as a cadet or trainee.
